Privacy Policy

HG Group and its subsidiaries complies with the New Zealand Privacy Act 2020 and the Australian Privacy Act 1988 when dealing with Personal Information.

Personal Information is information about an identifiable individual (a natural person). From time-to-time HG Group may take videos and photographs of goods it has supplied to various customer sites. Some videos and photographs may include images of people. Purpose for collection Personal Information

Disclosure of Personal Information

HG Group Ltd may disclose your personal information to other companies in the HG Group group of companies for our own business purposes. We may also disclose personal information to other organisations for example to:

- Third party contractors, who help conduct our business.
- Government or regulatory authorities where required or permitted by law.

HG Group will take all reasonable steps to ensure that any third-party organisations are bound by confidentiality and privacy obligations with respect to your personal information.

Under no circumstances will HG Group sell customer personal information without the written consent of the person to whom it relates.

Security of Personal Information

HG Group holds your personal information in electronic files. HG Group takes all reasonable steps to ensure that your personal information which is kept in its files is protected from misuse, interference, loss, unauthorised access, modification, and disclosure. HG Group takes all reasonable steps to protect personal information from unauthorised access or disclosure. HG Group continues to implement and maintain security controls within the organisation. These controls may include storing sensitive data where applicable behind a secure firewall where data is encrypted. We may also implement multi authentication to systems that have been flagged as storing sensitive data.

When your Personal Information is no longer needed for the purpose for which it was obtained, we will take reasonable steps to destroy or permanently de-identify your Personal Information. Personal Information will not be kept for longer than is required or for the purpose it may lawfully be used.
